Assignment Goal:

Apply principles of Web page design from Introductory reading and CH 1-5 of text.

This assignment should be coded using a theme for your pages as if you are coding for a realistic site, as much as possible. The quality of design and principles that we have been working on is part of the grading for this assignment. Plan your pages before you code, avoid deprecated code unless absolutely unavoidable, code using xhtml 1.1 strict and CSS 1.0 standards.

If you have trouble with a theme think about hobbies, activities, family themes, or fields of work you want to go into.

Specifically:

1. Proper use of DOCTYPE
2. Folder and File conventions
3. Beginning coding: Title, Section Headers, Paragraphs, Name elements for linking and styles
4. Include images in proper resolutions for use
5. Adjust placement of images
6. Apply formatting using xhtml/CSS from chapters 1-5
7. All links must work

Assignment requirements:

1. Create two pages where one is a main page. Pick a theme for your site that has meaning or purpose. Pages should be in different folders.
2. Link pages together so user can navigate between two pages. Include a third link to another website besides LCC or MSN.
3. Include Text with formatting from chapter 5 in particular, minimum 6 types.
4. Create a graphics using two different graphics formats.
5. Graphics must be a minimum of three different sizes and presentational purposes.
6. Create a link from a smaller graphic resolution (like a thumbnail) to the full size graphic image.
7. Apply formatting to graphics to change presentational layout.

Assignment grading is based on two criteria. Did you meet each assignment criteria, and how well did you apply principles studied to date. This includes no use of deprecated code, xhtml methods used, links work, syntax correct.
